This block should be a 12 inch block finished. There are $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowances. There are a total of 9 colors. Details can be hand embroidered or drawn on with a permanent fabric marker. There are several wedges that come together to create the block. Enjoy! For personal/non-commercial use only. If you have any questions or comments, please email me oddetsy@gmail.com

Construction is as follows:

MAIN:

Make A. Set aside.

Make (B+C+D+E) = FACE

Make F+(G+H+I+J). Join to FACE.

Make K. Join to FACE.

Make L. Join to FACE. Set aside.

Make (M+N+O) + (P+Q+R+S) = SHOULDER. Set aside.

Make (T+U+V+W+X+Y) = BODY. Set aside.

Make (Z+AA+(AB+AC)). Join to BODY.

Make AD. Join to BODY.

Join SHOULDER + BODY = BODY.

Make AE. Join to BODY.

Join FACE + BODY = GRINCH.

Make (AF+AG+AH). Join to GRINCH.

Join A to GRINCH = MAIN.

SIDE:

Make AI+AJ = SKY. Set aside.

Make AK+(AL+AM)+AN+AO = CHIMNEY.

Make AP. Join to CHIMNEY.

Make AQ+AR. Join to CHIMNEY.

Make (AS+AT)+AU+AV. Join to CHIMNEY.

Join SKY + CHIMNEY = SIDE.

Join MAIN + SIDE.

Embroider or use a fabric marker to draw on details.
